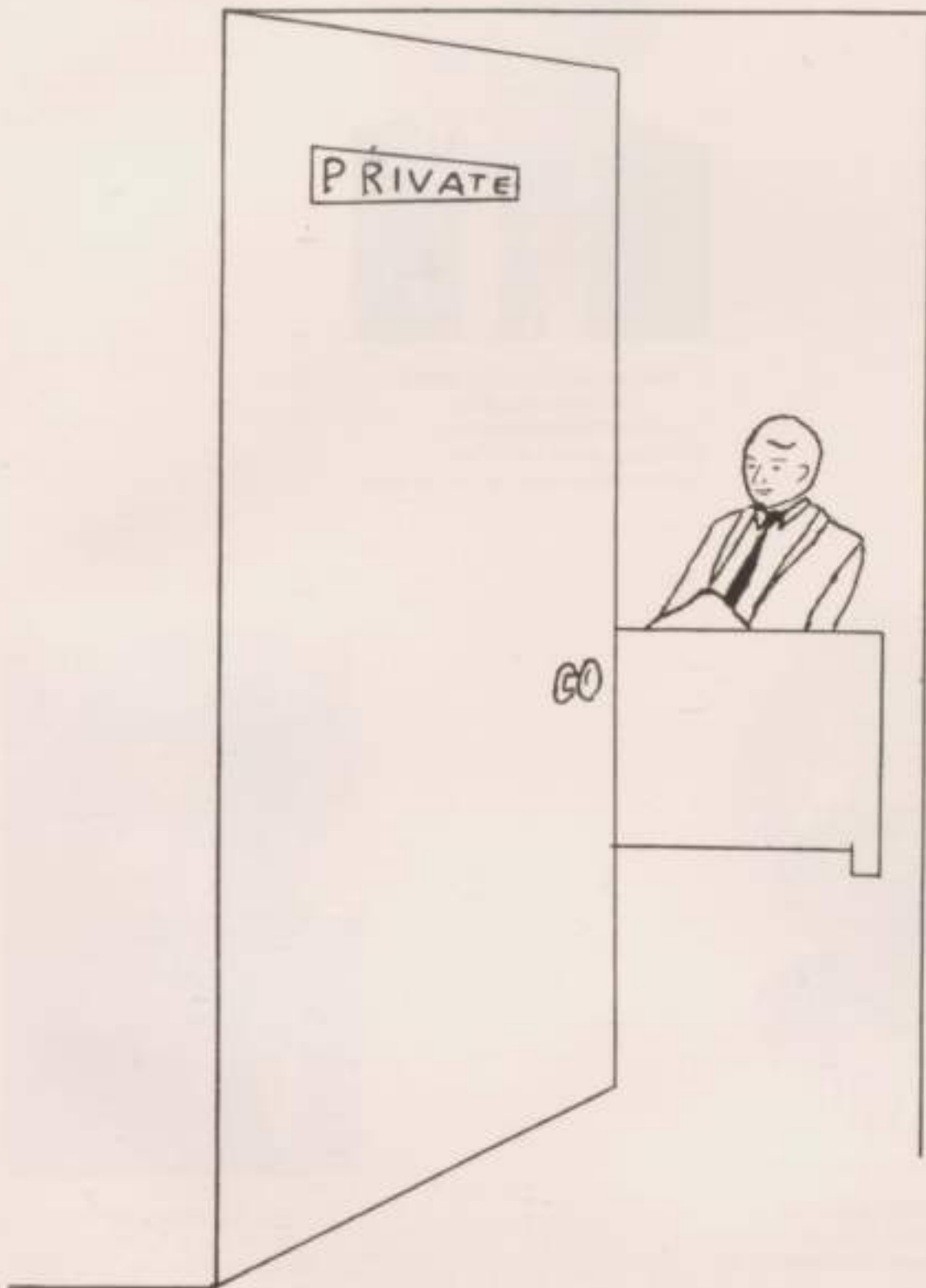

Class History

It doesn't seem so long ago when we appeared at Mrs. Osgood's door complete with shiny noses, pencil boxes, tablets and stiff new dresses and shirts. Then all we could say was a shy hello to the other boys and girls.

The sandboxes and blocks and dollhouses didn't last long enough for most of us, but we pushed on anyway into 1st grade. We were in big business now. From Mrs. Cooley and Mrs. Riley we learned to read and we attended school the whole day instead of just half of one. Then to the 2nd grade with Mrs. Kline's Easter bonnet parade. And of course we can't forget the mock marriage of Norma Cupp to Joe Bingaman--complete with a kiss from the groom. We hopped on to 3rd grade to Mrs. Price and Mrs. Hudson. Those who had Mrs. Price hopped clear to the new school--which had been finished just a few years before. When we arrived in Mrs. Black's room we were 4th graders and we were old enough to put on a play. With the help of our music teacher, we picked THE WIZARD OF OZ. There was big argument over who would play Dorothy, but Linda Robinson finally stole the part and even did a fancy ballet to "Somewhere Over the Rainbow". Then to 5th grade with Mrs. Bloom, Freddie and Marina. When we reached Mrs. Bennett's room, we'd reached the last year of our elementary education. There's lots of things to remember from 5th grade--John Highly buying popicles for Ginger Cordes, the tipping over of chairs, the 2nd Easter bonnet parade, and the squabbles over the baseball diamond. We left elementary school in the spring of 1961, and in the fall we were in junior high. It was a big change--five new teachers and no recesses, but we managed, and at the end of the year we celebrated with a swimming party at the YWCA. When we were juniors, we were faced with all those tests which are required by colleges. Ginger Cordes was elected Miss Ski Apparel at the annual Snow Carnival, and we planned the Junior-Senior Prom. Then we were seniors--the leaders of the school. A senior year is a very special year--Government Day, the senior trip, the ordering of announcements, the concession stand--all things which only seniors do.

When graduation rolls around, we can't really be sorry because when we look back, we can realize that it has been an awfully good thirteen years together.
