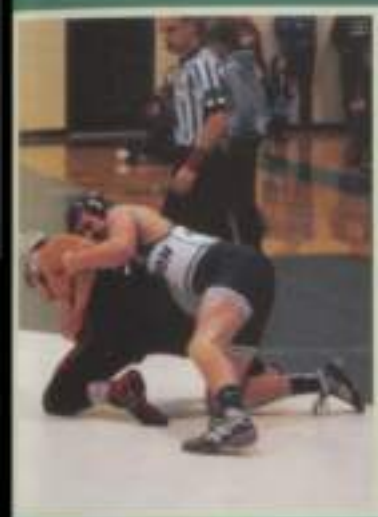
## 2014-2015

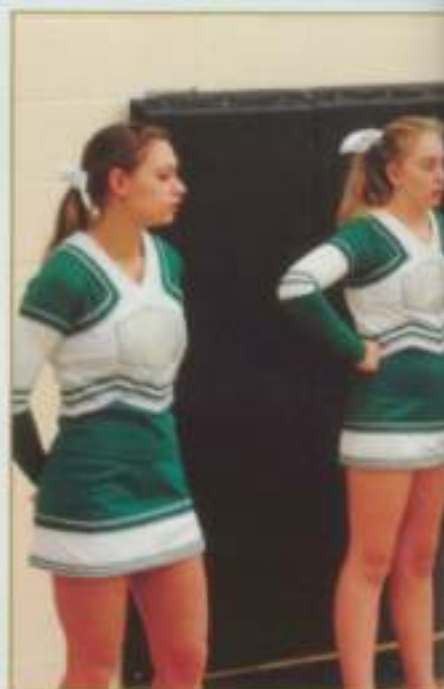

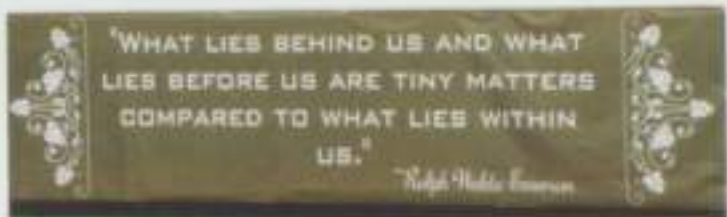

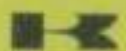
